- **Program supplies, including t-shirts and patches, accident insurance, all activity materials, program supplies and pizza on Friday.**

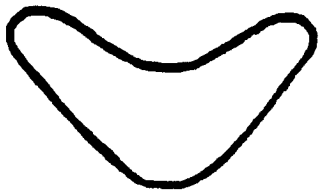

**Tiger Cubs MUST be accompanied at all times by their Adult Partner.**



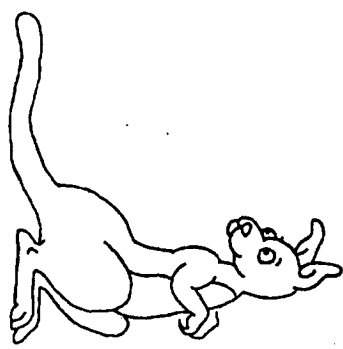
**Volunteers: Each pack MUST send 1 leader for every 8 boys.**

**Directions to Knox Park in Athens  
Site of Unaka District Cub Scout Day Camp**

Located off Madison Avenue, go past Mayfield Dairy Farms, turn right onto Slack Rd. Turn into entrance of Knox Park and bear to the right to go towards the baseball field on top of the hill to Cub Scout Day Camp Headquarters area.

Pull up to the DROP-OFF/PICK-UP sign. A staff member will be there to sign your boy in and out in the morning and evening, You will then continue out the "EXIT" drive.
