## Adult Leader Training Opportunities

### Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills (IOLS)

This course is intended for every adult leader in every Boy Scout Troop. It is designed to provide a working knowledge of the basic outdoor skills necessary to succeed as a Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster. Outdoor skills are critical to the success of the Scouting program, and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills will provide leaders with the basic outdoor skills information needed to start a program right.

The skills taught are based on those found in The Boy Scout Handbook. The course is also ideal for Webelos Den Leaders and Venturing Leaders because it focuses on skills that build confidence and competence in leaders conducting outdoor camping experiences. Course topics include:

- Campsite Selection
- Ropes - Whipping, Tying, and Lashing
- Woods Tools
- Fire
- Site Preparation and Building
- Cooking
- First Aid
- Animal & Plant Identification
- Packing and Hiking Techniques
- Map and Compass
- Leave No Trace



A troop leader is considered trained upon completion of Fast Start Orientation, This is Scouting, and all four parts of Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training.

Troop committee members and Webelos leaders who plan to move into a leadership position in a troop are encouraged to complete this training as well.

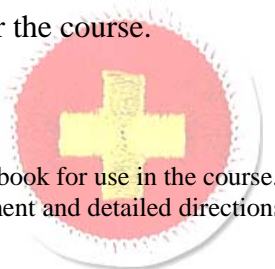
Cost is \$25 per person which includes meals and materials.
