### **101 The NEW Cub Leader Specific Training**

Basic Leadership Training for Tiger Cub Den Leaders, Wolf & Bear Cub Den Leaders, Webelos Den Leaders, Cumbasters and Pack Committee Members. This course is required for a leader to be considered "trained" in their position. In this course we explore the NEW Den Meeting and achievement model.

### **102 The Cub Outdoor Program**

Boys and outdoors go together and the Cub Scout program takes full advantage of that fact. This session will give you ideas on how to use the outdoor program in your pack planning activities.

### **103 Awards & Ceremonies**

The Scouting program is filled with awards and ceremonies designed to convey the importance of the event and the achievement of the Scout. A well organized ceremony sets the tone for the event. Ceremonies and awards programs don't have to be complicated, but they have to be important.

### **104 Putting FUN in the Program**

If it isn't fun, boys won't be interested. In this session we'll explore ways to design activities as "fun with a purpose."

### **105 UPDATE: The NEW Cub Den Program**

In a pilot study of 21 dens in Bay-Lakes Council using this program, the retention rate of Cub Scouts went from 64% to 85%. In packs where some of the dens were using the program and other dens were not, the retention increased significantly for those using the program and did not increase for those not using the program. Equally important, den leaders using the program were very happy with it and felt it made their job as a den leader much easier and more enjoyable. ### **201 Scoutmaster & ASM Leader Specific Training**

Basic Leadership Training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters. This course is the first of two that are required for a leader to be considered "trained" in their position. (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills training will be offered in November to complete the required SM/ASM training plan).

### **202 How to Train Youth Leaders**

A Boy-Led troop is the goal of the Boy Scouting program and it's the job of the Scoutmaster to train the youth leadership in that vital role. Troop Leadership Training is the first step in the Youth Leadership Development plan of the BSA.

### **203 Planning Events & Outings**

A successful outing is one that is planned well in advance. From securing the necessary tour permits, to arranging for safe, reliable transportation, there's a lot to planning a Scouting event.

### **204 Scoutmaster Conferences & Boards of Review**

An essential element of the BSA Advancement program is regular evaluation of a Scout's progress and goals. Scoutmaster Conferences help boys set goals and Boards of Review continually evaluate the effectiveness of the unit's program. Learn how to take full advantage of both tools!

### **401 Pack & Troop Alliances**

Cub Scout Packs and Boy Scout Troops are the perfect compliment to each other. Building a good relationship with another unit will increase scout retention, increase resources, and make for a stronger program.

### **402 Delivering The Program**

Delivering a strong Scouting program is the responsibility of the Unit Leadership, but where do you turn for help? The answer is your Unit Commissioner! In this session we'll discuss how the Unit Commissioner guides the leaders in the delivery of a quality program.
