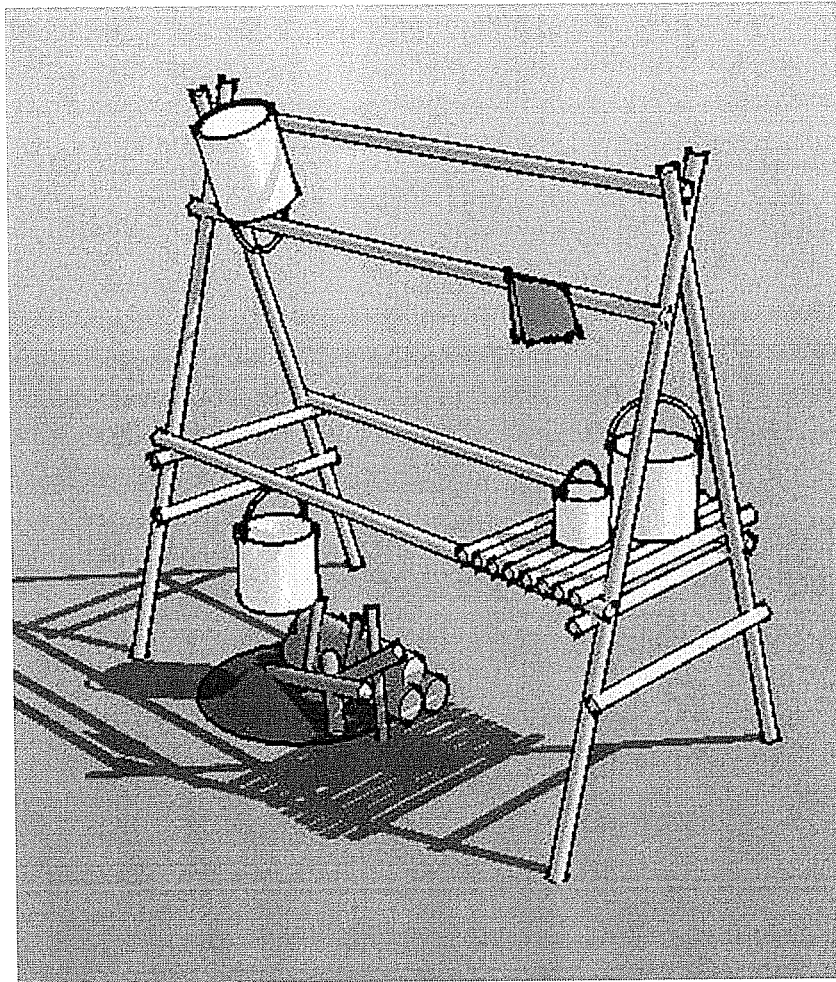


# Unaka Freeze-O-Ree 2014

## EVENTS

### LASHING CHIPPAWAH KITCHEN

### COOKING COMPETITION

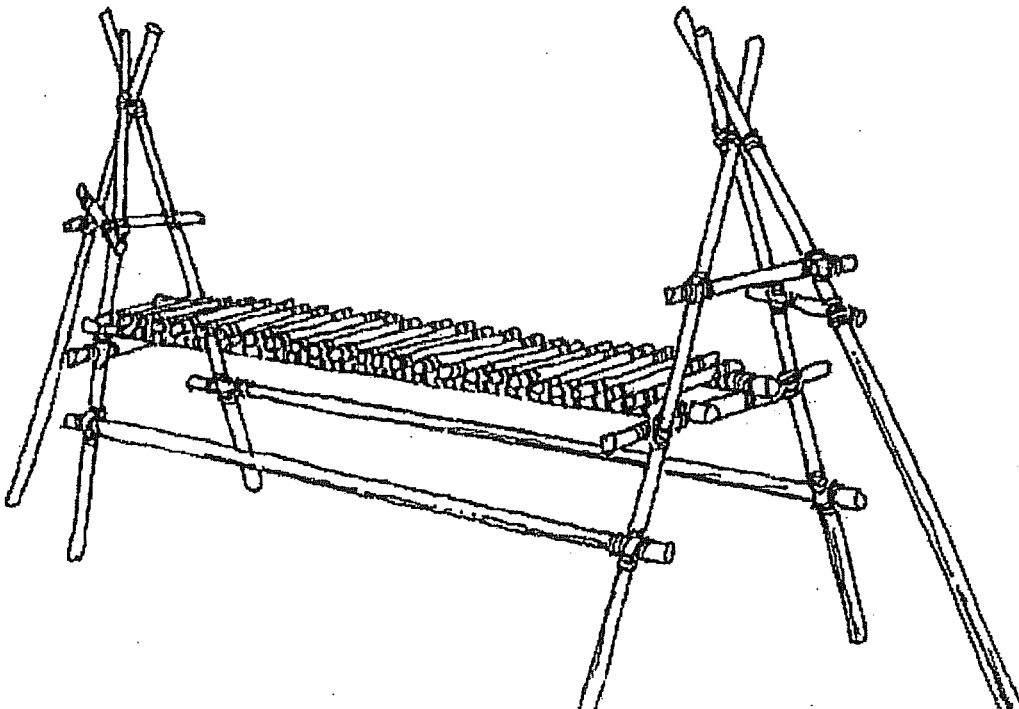
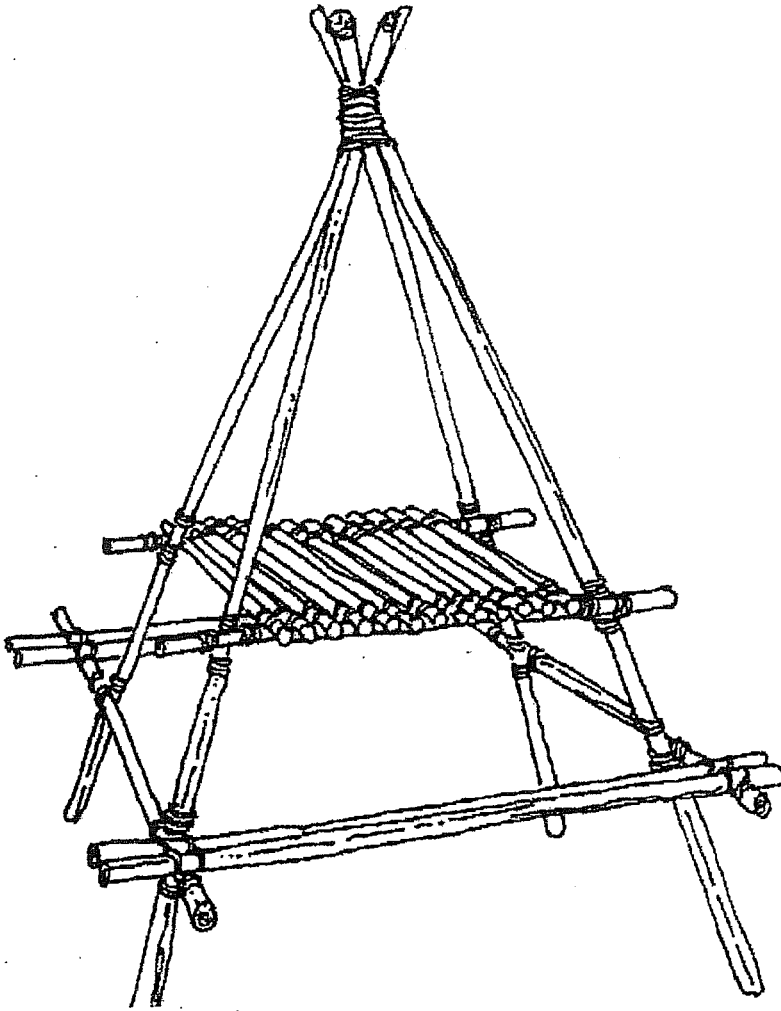
THE COMPETITION WILL BE A "ONE POT MEAL" IN A DUTCH OVEN OR LARGE POT.  
THE MEAL MUST CONTAIN A MEAT, A VEGETABLE (ONE OR MORE), AND A "CARB" (EITHER POTATO OR PASTA).  
THE COMPETITION WILL BE JUDGED ON FLAVOR, ORIGINALITY, AND VISUAL APPEAL. (HOW GOOD IT LOOKS)  
THE MEAL MUST BE TURNED IN AT 5:00 PM FOR JUDGING.

### TUG OF WAR

TROOPS WILL SELECT UP TO SIX BOYS TO COMPETE. THE TOTAL WEIGHT OF THE TEAM CAN NOT BE MORE THAN 800 LBS. TEAMS WILL COMPETE BY RANDOM DRAWING TO A SET OF BRACKETTS.  
IT WILL BE A SINGLE ELIMINATION EVENT. THE EVENT WILL BE HELD AS A CAMP EVENT SO EVERYONE CAN WATCH.
