### **101 The NEW Cub Leader Specific Training**

Basic Leadership Training for Tiger Cub Den Leaders, Wolf & Bear Cub Den Leaders, Webelos Den Leaders, Cumbasters and Pack Committee Members. This course is required for a leader to be considered "trained" in their position. In this course we explore the NEW Den Meeting and achievement model.

### **102 The Cub Outdoor Program**

Boys and outdoors go together and the Cub Scout program takes full advantage of that fact. This session will give you ideas on how to use the outdoor program in your pack planning activities.

### **103 Beyond Advancement**

The Cub advancement program is fun, but there are so many unit-level activities, awards and programs that can make take your program from fun to fantastic!

### **104 UPDATE: The NEW Cub Den Program**

In a pilot study of 21 dens in Bay-Lakes Council using this program, the retention rate of Cub Scouts went from 64% to 85%. In packs where some of the dens were using the program and other dens were not, the retention increased significantly for those using the program and did not increase for those not using the program. Equally important, den leaders using the program were very happy with it and felt it made their job as a den leader much easier and more enjoyable. ### **201 Scoutmaster & ASM Leader Specific Training**

Basic Leadership Training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters. This course is the first of two that are required for a leader to be considered "trained" in their position. (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills training will be offered in November to complete the required SM/ASM training plan).

### **202 How to Train Youth Leaders**

A Boy-Led troop is the goal of the Boy Scouting program and it's the job of the Scoutmaster to train the youth leadership in that vital role. Troop Leadership Training is the first step in the Youth Leadership Development plan of the BSA.

### **203 Eagle Scout Service Project Planning**

The Eagle Scout Service Project requires the scout to conceive, prepare, implement and summarize a service project while showcasing the scout's leadership skills. In this session we'll discuss the new requirements for the project workbook and how to get it approved quickly.

### **401 Scouting Beyond Your Unit**

BSA offers so many programs for youth that it's hard to keep up. In this session, you'll discover numerous adventure programs for both Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts that will supplement the program already delivered in your unit

### **402 Planning Events & Outings**

A successful outing is one that is planned well in advance. From securing the necessary tour permits, to arranging for safe, reliable transportation, there's a lot to planning a Scouting event.
